

**DEWITT SCHOOL BOARD  
CALLED MEETING  
July 19, 2016**

The Board of Directors of the DeWitt School District met in a special called meeting on July 19, 2016, at 5:00 p.m. in the Board Room of the Administration Building for the purpose of personnel and other matters.
