

DEWITT SCHOOL BOARD
CALLED MEETING
May 31, 2017

The Board of Directors of the DeWitt School District met in a called meeting on May 31, 2017 at 6:00 p.m. in the Board Room of the Administration Building for the consideration of personnel and an MOU with Stuttgart for a Psychological Examiner.

- Accept the recommendation to terminate the employment of Joy Smith as cafeteria worker effective May 21, 2017.

Second by Mrs. Wansley. Motion carried 6-0
