ARKANSAS COUNTY FARM BUREAU SCHOLARSHIP
REQUIREMENTS

1. Student or parent must have been a member of Arkansas County Farm Bureau for a minimum of three (3) years.
2. Student must attend a college or university.
3. Grant will be for one (1) year subject to renewal if requirements are met.
4. Must have a 2.5 high school grade point and be recommended by the high school.
5. Must maintain a 2.25 grade point for two semesters on the average in college.
6. Must be a full time student—must carry twelve (12) hours or be considered a full time student by the institution or, part time student carrying six (6) hours at Phillips Community College may qualify for half of current grant. Full time students may qualify for full grant.
7. Students will major in an **agri-related** subject, if funds are available other majors may be considered.
8. Payments will be limited to eight (8) semesters.
